

Councillor Question Time

Question from Councillor Sirakoff:

Alongside the concrete blocks going up on designated pop-up bike lanes, will the Department of Transport (DoT) also be putting up any other concrete blocks elsewhere alongside the yellow lines, which I've witnessed today?

Response:

Following the Council resolution at the 20 July Council meeting, Council wrote to the Department of Transport (DoT) requesting changes to the pop-up bike lane program and outlining community concerns. Council received a response from Alan Fedda, Executive Director Inner Metro, Department of Transport outlining DoT's changes to pop up bike lanes across a variety of locations across the City of Port Phillip.

Council resolved at its meeting on 7 September to endorse the DoT pop up bike lane changes and continual monitoring of the trial as detailed in the Council Report.

At the date of this request, 3 August DoT were 95% complete of all orca, speed cushion and bollard installations – so very little civil work remaining at that stage, mostly on Marine Parade.

An update on the progress of the trial will be provided to Councillors by the end of this year.
