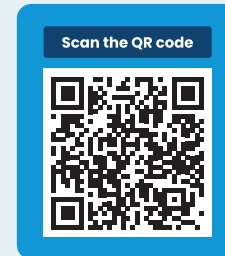

DISCONTINUANCE OF MOUBRAY STREET, ALBERT PARK
BETWEEN WITHERS STREET AND BRIDPORT STREET WEST**

The City of Port Phillip writes to advise that it is commencing legal procedures pursuant to sections 207 and 223 and clause 3 of schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 2020 ('the Act') to discontinue part of Moubray Street, Albert Park, between Withers Street and Bridport Street West.

This section of Moubray Street has been closed since 2013 and operates as an informal park.

Email submissions can be made online at haveyoursay.portphillip.vic.gov.au or posted to 'Moubray Street Community Park – proposed road discontinuance' at City of Port Phillip, Private Bag 3, PO St Kilda VIC 3182. The closing date for a written submission is 5pm Wednesday 19 October 2022.

If you (or a person acting on your behalf) wish to speak to your submission, you must complete a 'Request to speak' form, available on Council's website at www.portphillip.vic.gov.au.

Council will meet at 6.30pm on 16 November 2022 in the St Kilda Town Hall, 99a Carlisle Street, St Kilda. The Council will hear those persons wishing to be heard in support of their written submission.
