

Overview of Engagement Activities for Park Street

Engagement activities

The engagement activities for the Park Street Streetscape Project will include:

- Letterbox notification to surrounding properties (residents and businesses)
- Corflute signage placed along the street
- Website update
- Have Your Say survey with Frequently Asked Questions - open for one month
- Meeting with key local stakeholders
- Drop-in sessions (COVID-19 health advice dependent)
- social media posts.

Have Your Say survey:

The survey focuses on changes proposed in light of community feedback received. This reflects that previous engagement undertaken as part of the Domain Precinct Masterplan canvassed community sentiment about the Park Street streetscape and installation of a protected bike lane. Below is a summarised version of the survey:

- Do you support the retention of four parking spaces on Park Street?
- Do you support the proposed parking control changes to short term and service parking on Park Street?
- Do you support the proposed change to angle parking on Bank Street to create additional parking spaces?
- Do you support the proposed conversion of existing long stay parking to short-term parking on Bank Street?
- Do you support converting up to four existing parking spaces on Wells Street and Palmerston Crescent to loading zones and/or 15-minute parking?
- Do you support the conversion of Little Bank Street into an improved pedestrian link? What features would entice you to use it/ what concerns would prevent you from using it?
- Any other feedback?
