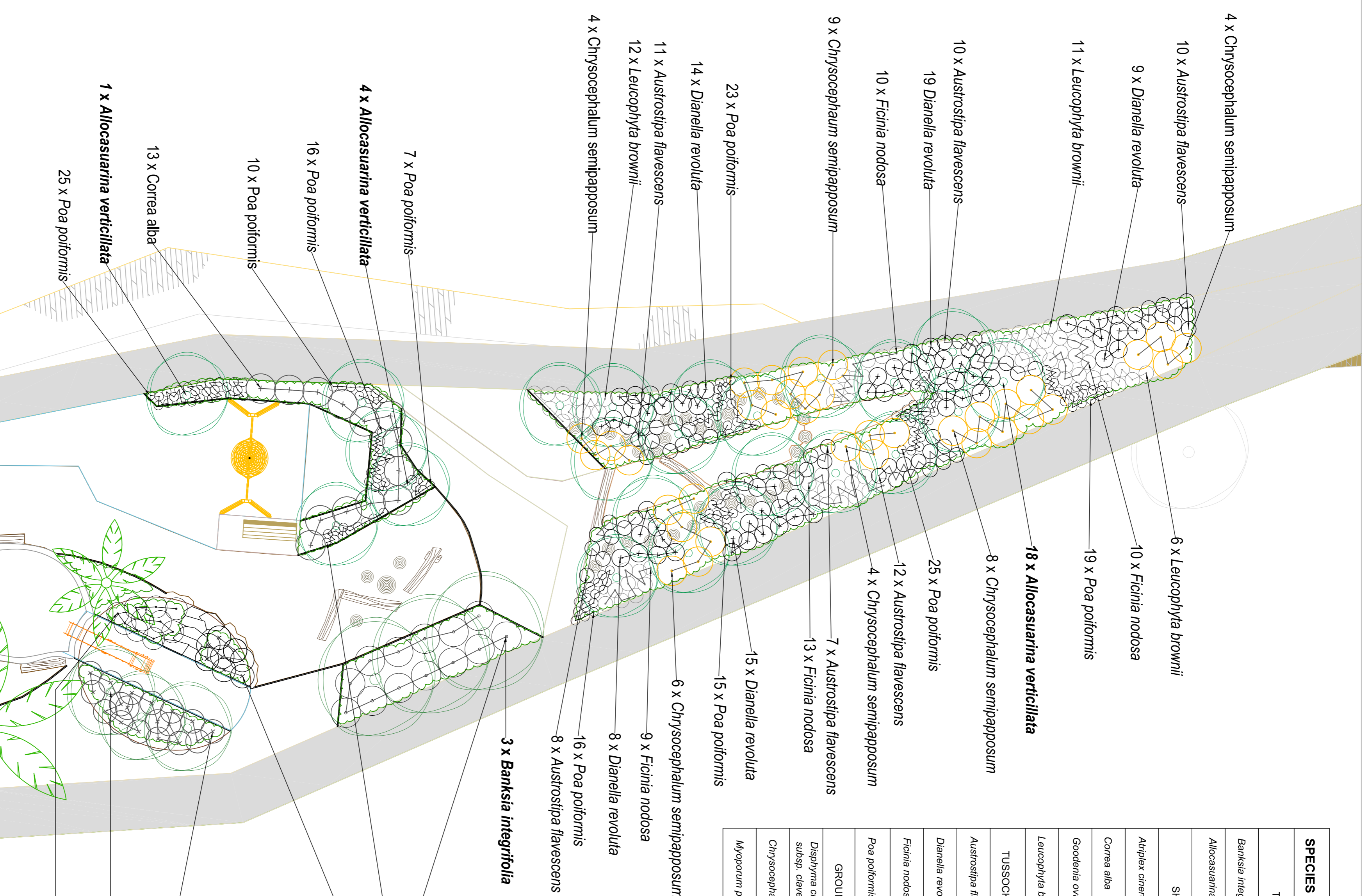

**PLANTING NOTES**

- WORK NEAR TREES**
1. ESTABLISH TREE PROTECTION ZONES AROUND ALL EXISTING TREES TO BE RETAINED.
  2. ENSURE NO SOIL COMPACTION OCCURS WITHIN THE ROOT ZONES OF EXISTING TREES. FENCE OFF ROOT ZONES PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORKS.
  3. DEMOLITION OF ANY STRUCTURES ADJACENT TO ANY TREE TO BE RETAINED IS TO BE UNDERTAKEN IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT IMPACT ON ANY ADJACENT TREE CANOPIES AND/OR ROOT ZONE AREA.
  4. WHEN ANY EXCAVATION IS REQUIRED IN THE VICINITY OF ANY TREES TO BE RETAINED, HAND EXCAVATION SHALL FIRST BE MADE TO LOCATE ANY ROOTS. IF DIRECTED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT, EQUIPMENT SHALL BE KEPT CLEAR OF ANY TREES AND HAND METHOD OF EXCAVATION SHALL BE ADOPTED.
  5. ROOTS WHICH ARE TO BE AFFECTED BY THE OF PROPOSED WORK SHALL BE CLEAN CUT, CLEAR OF THE WORK BEFORE MACHINE EXCAVATION COMMENCES WITH A SHARP SAW FOR THIS PURPOSE. REMOVAL OF TREE ROOTS GREATER THAN 50mm IN DIAMETER SHALL REQUIRE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE SUPERINTENDENT.
- PLANTING**
1. SETOUT OF ALL PLANTING TO BE CONFIRMED ON SITE BY SUPERINTENDENT PRIOR TO PLANTING.
  2. REFER TO DETAIL SHEET FOR TREE AND GARDEN BED PLANTING DETAIL.
  3. ALL MULCHED GARDEN BEDS SHOULD FINISH FLUSH WITH ADJACENT SURFACE. ALL GARDEN BEDS TO BE MULCHED WITH 75MM SHREDED PINE BARK MULCH OR APPROVED EQUIVALENT.
- GENERAL NOTES**
1. UNDERGROUND SERVICES MUST NOT BE DISTURBED.
  2. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE THERE ARE NO RIP HAZARDS AND ALL NEW SURFACES ARE FLUSH WITH ADJACENT SURFACES UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.
