



17.2 Confidential-Aged Care Reforms

Purpose

- 1.2 To seek endorsement to undertake client, community, and staff engagement on the proposed aged care delivery model.

That Council:

- 3.1 Confirms its commitment to supporting older persons to age positively in our community.
- 3.2 Notes the Commonwealth's Aged Care Reforms drive a need for Council to review the way it delivers services to older persons to ensure they are feasible, relevant, effective, efficient, sustainable and deliver best value.
- 3.3 Endorses the proposed future service delivery model for Council's aged care services, outlined in this report for clients, community, staff, and union consultation including a small increase in Council funding for aged care services.
- 3.4 Notes that the formal consultation process with current clients, community, staff, and unions is proposed to commence from November to early December 2023 with the results reported back to Council in December 2023.
- 3.5 Notes the planned adoption of an aged care delivery model in February 2024 following consideration of client, community, staff, and union feedback.
- 3.6 Requests officers to work with the Commonwealth to ensure clients and community within Port Phillip are appropriately supported during the implementation of Aged Care Reforms and any subsequent adjustments to Council's service offering with the adoption of an aged care service delivery model in February 2024.
- 3.7 Commits to providing appropriate support for impacted staff with the adoption of an aged care service delivery model in February 2024
