# A community exhibition of favourite books and reading accoutrements. How to enter:

1. Select your book or object (bookend, book-mark, glasses and so on) and take a digital photograph.

For books or comics take a photograph of the cover, the publisher's blurb on the back cover and any notes on the author.

2. Write up a few words (up to 300) about your connection to the book/author/object.

#### For example:

- How did you come to by the book/object; was it a gift or recommendation?
- How has the book influenced you; or what did you like about it?
- Why the book/object is special to you (a family heirloom, an antique or gift perhaps?)
- If for some reason you cannot take a photograph, send us your contact details, the title and author of the book and your write up and we will endeavour to source the book from Port Phillip Library shelves.
