At the time, his village was occupied by German forces, who used his house as a hospital and communications post, due to its elevated position. George's book *IFTHESHOE FITS* is about his family and follows seven generations of culture, conflict, achievement, compassion and understanding.

"Occasionally, a moment, a memory, a meeting or an event changes the way you live your life. Finding my sister Agapi's grave in the grounds of a church in a rural village inspired me to find out more about my family and the hardships they endured during two world wars and civil wars.
