

#### 17.1 Confidential Notice of Motion - Councillor Marcus Pearl - Potential Acquisition

#### **MOVED Crs Pearl/Cunsolo**

That Council

- Notes that 509 Williamstown Road and 203 Ingles Street, Port Melbourne are strategic opportunities to make an important contribution to open space for the future community at Fishermans Bend.
- 2. Authorises the CEO (or delegate) to carry out of due diligence for the potential purchase of the site, including the serving of notice(s) of intention to enter land to investigate and assess the site, and to commence negotiations for the purchase of the sites if necessary.
- 3. Requests that an update be provided to councillors within two months, outlining the available options for council to directly purchase the site, and to fund that purchase including council reserves and state and federal grants, but excluding external debt.
- 4. Requests the Mayor write to the Victorian Government and relevant Ministers:
  - detailing the pressures of growth on public space, sport, and recreation facilities in Fishermans Bend
  - of the Council's position that the Australia Post, DHL, and Prohasky sites should be acquired as soon as possible for community sport, recreation, and public space provision
  - of Council's willingness to make a funding contribution towards this while noting the pressures of rates capping and that contributions revenue will flow to the State.
- 5 Directs the CEO to advocate for the position detailed in point 4.
