Fundraising and Raffles

Fundraising can come in many different forms, from a gold coin entry fee, to shaking a tin, to running a raffle. Confirmation and permissions are required for most forms of fundraising to ensure that regulations are being met. This document outlines your requirements as an event provider.

Permissions

Any person who conducts a raffle or fundraises on behalf of a community or charitable organisation must have written consent of the governing body of that organisation. This can take the form of an email or letter.

Raffles

If the total retail value of prizes exceeds \$5,000, your organisation must be registered with and/or have gained approval from the Victorian Commission for Gambling & Casino Control (VGCCC) to conduct raffles. Food and beverage
