MID - SENIOR PRIMARY SCHOOL (TWEENS)

These are examples of equipment we could use in this area of the playground.

- Composite structures allow the child to use equipment going up and down, over and under, slanted or flat etc.
- Includes experiences such as climbing, balancing, moving through a space / area
- Challenging equipment to develop coordination and strength
- Encourages problem solving



TODDLER / JUNIOR PLAY

Examples of equipment we could use in this area of the playground. This type of equipment provides the opportunity to discover and explore by climbing, jumping, balancing, sliding and discovering.



TEENAGER CHILL OUT ZONE

- Encourages adventure for physical / extreme challenges
- A place to chill out with friends
- Encourages fitness and agility
- Is separate and offers an element of privacy



NETBALL COURTS

Netball court resurfacing to be completed early 2017 as part of Sport and Recreation upgrade works.



EXPLORE WITH NATURE PLAY

Nature based play fosters imagination and creative play. It is a form of self designed play and offers the opportunity for creative learning and improved socialisation. This area of the playground will stepping stones, log walks, sensory garden, shapes such as tunnels and waves, and multi level platforms / decks.



JUNIOR - MID PRIMARY SCHOOL

Similar to the mid - senior primary school play area, this style of equipment provides opportunities for group play and interaction.

- Provides an opportunity to engage in group play
- Swinging and spinning are known experiences that can be developed further
- Provides short and varied activity

The aim of this concept design it is to incorporate the key points that we received through the stage 1 Have Your Say process. The design includes a variety of play equipment to cater to a variety of age groups. To improve the shade, new / additional tree planting has been included and the equipment has been strategically placed where it will benefit from the shade. Additional seating includes picnic areas, benches (with backs), seating adjacent to the netball courts and a mixture of fun and non traditional seating scattered throughout the playground areas.
